Dear Sisters and Brothers:

The Pennsylvania AFL-CIO is pleased to announce its <u>2025 Scholarship Essay Contest</u>. We thank affiliate unions that have contributed to the award money for the Scholarship Essay Contests, in the past. Now we are writing to request your financial support and your help in promoting the 2025 Essay Contest.

The Essay Contest provides an opportunity for high school and post-secondary students to learn about the Labor Movement's important contributions to the social, economic, and political development of our country. It also reminds students – the next generation of workers – about the importance of protecting the Labor Movement's gains, for their own wellbeing in current and future workplaces.

Awards are offered to students in two categories: Graduating High School Seniors (class of 2025) and All Post-Secondary Students. The award amounts are: First Place - \$2,000, Second Place - \$1,500. Third Place - \$1,000.

The essay topics for each category are as follows:

Category I – Graduating High School Seniors:

How do Labor Unions align with broader social justice movements? In your opinion, what role do Unions play in advocating equality and equity in the workplace?

Category II - Students Attending an Accredited, Post-Secondary Institution:

Labor Unions often play a significant role in politics. How do you think unions should engage with political systems, and what should be their focus when advocating for workers' interests?

If you post this information on your website, please note that the scholarships are only awarded to Pennsylvania AFL-CIO affiliated union members and their immediate family members. All submissions must be received by email to monica@paaficio.org by April 15, 2025. Essays will be judged in May 2025, and awards will be made in June 2025.

Scholarships are available exclusively to Pennsylvania AFL-CIO affiliated union members and their immediate family members.

Scholarships are offered to students in two categories: graduating high school seniors (Class of 2025), and all post-secondary students.

Essay Contest Categories

Labor unions have a rich history of aligning with broader social justice movements, fighting for economic and social equality for all. To effectively champion workers' interests, unions must actively engage in the political arena, lobbying for pro-worker legislation, supporting progressive candidates, and educating the public on the importance of a strong labor movement.

Category 1: Graduating High School Seniors

Category 2: Post-Secondary Students

Rules and Application Form

The Category I applicant must be a graduating high school senior, be enrolled in a full-time degree program or a fully accredited institution. The applicant's parent, legal guardian or grandparent is a full dues-paying Affiliate Union member of The Greater Johnstown/Somerset CLC, AFL-CIO or applicant is a student enrolled in one of the High Schools located in Cambria or Somerset Counties.

The <u>Category II</u> applicant at the time the scholarship is awarded, be enrolled in a fulltime degree program or a fully accredited institution. The applicant's parent, legal guardian or grandparent must be a full duespaying Affiliate Union member of The Greater Johnstown/Somerset CLC, AFL-CIO.

Applicants must submit a 1,000-word essay on the subject assigned to their appropriate category.

The essay must be typed and neatly prepared. The titles must be kept as they appear on this brochure and the application form must be filled out completely.

The Essay and Application form must be mailed with a postmark of no later than April 8, 2025 to be judged.
